A WONDERFUL 7 DAY ADVENTURE

Wednesday 1 April—Tuesday 7 April 2



Venture to the High Country of Victoria and spend your days discovering regions with rich history, stunning autumn colours and celebrate the country passion at The Man from Snowy River Bush Festival.

Day 1: HOME TO GOULBURN - Wed 1 Apr 2020

Welcome to our tour to Albury featuring the Man from Snowy River Bush Festival. Sit back and relax as the blazing colours of autumn are in full force with deep ruby reds, browns of every hue, rich yellows and vivid pinks dazzling everywhere you look. We depart the Port Macquarie Coach terminal at 8.00am making our way to Goulburn for our first night on tour together

Day 2: GOULBURN TO ALBURY - Thu 2 Apr 2020

Continuing the journey, we stop in Yass to explore the home of the first Australian-born explorer, Hamilton Hume, at Cooma Cottage. As our guide leads us through this fine example of a pioneer dwelling, we truly capture the lives they must have led. We travel to Holbrook

where you might think it's a bit odd to find a life-sized submarine in the middle of the rural NSW town. Our visit to the Submarine Museum will reveal why the HMAS Otway's final resting place came to be Holbrook. Through an amazing holograph presentation, we'll hear how a brave young Submariner, whose



exploits during the First World War earned him the honour of having the town named after him. We call into the National Museum of Australian Pottery — another of the towns interesting attractions. Established in 1995, this is the only museum in Australia dedicated to 19th and 20th century Australian pottery. We continue onto Albury, to unpack and settle in, as this will be our home for the next four nights.

(breakfast & dinner in hotel / lunch at own expense) Albury Manor House (PH: 02 60411777 This morning we have a look around Albury.

First, we visit the Albury Railway Station, which in 1883, became a "change over station" for passengers between Melbourne and Sydney due to the different railing gauge used in the two states. Prominent hills lie at each end of Dean Street and offer excellent vistas of Albury and the surrounds. Once aptly named Eastern Hill and Western Hill, a memorial Pillar (to the

Soldiers of WWI)

resulted in the name change from Western Hill to Monument Hill. Whether flood lit at night or overseeing the going's-on of Dean Street during the day, it is a most impressive landmark — and a great opportunity for a group photograph! Next, we visit the Army Museum Bandiana, where we explore the comprehensive displays, artefacts of the Boer War to Vietnam and vehicles dating back to the 1920s. With an experienced

guide at the Bonegilla Migrant Experience, we discover the history of 'Block 19', the last remaining block on the site which received and trained migrants to Australia following World War Two. We travel to Corryong where we join the festivities of the 2020 Man from Snowy River Festival. Be engaged with live entertainment, a re-enactment of Banjo's famous poem, hear the recital of the iconic poem and witness the arrival of the horses in the main street.

Day 4: MAN FROM SNOWY RIVER FESTIVAL - Sat 4 Apr 2020

We head back to Corryong for a full day at the Man from Snowy River Festival. There is a lot happening here today over the festival including a visit to the Man from Snowy River Museum, experience fantastic live entertainment, demonstrations and much more. With plenty of food and beverage stalls to choose from you will easily settle your appetite before the Street Parade.

Local vehicles, schools, poets and horse enthusiasts will combine with a variety of historical machinery to modern day Utes. They all participate in a well-choreographed parade, making it one of the highlights of the Festival

We travel to Benalla to meet our local guide who will showcase some of the amazing street art. Artists from around the world were brought together to paint murals on bare walls, some over three stories high. Not far, is the Goorambat Silo, painted by iconic street artist Dvate, known for his striking renditions of endangered animals. Look up at the rural landscape and endangered Barking Owl featured on the silos. Here we also see the "Sophia" mural in the Uniting Church, painted by well-known Melbourne based street artist, Adnate.

We head to Yarrawonga where we join the Sienna Daisy for a lunch cruise on the tranquil waters of Lake Mulwala. We finish our day with a delightful wine tasting in Rutherglen.
