Day 1: HOME TO GOULBURN – Wed 7 Apr 2021 (D)

Welcome to our tour to **Albury** featuring the **Man from Snowy River Bush Festival**. We depart the Port Macquarie Coach Terminal at 8.00am. Sit back and relax as the blazing colours of autumn are in full force with deep ruby reds, browns of every hue, rich yellows and vivid pinks dazzling everywhere you look.

Day 7: SOUTHERN HIGHLANDS TO HOME – Tue 13 Apr 2021 (BL)

Our travels today take us through the western side of Sydney to lunch at the **Karuah RSL Club** before arriving home from a fabulous tour featuring the Man from Snowy River Festival (breakfast at Mittagong RSL Club / lunch included).

We make our way to **Goulburn** for our first night on tour together (lunch at own expense / dinner in hotel)

Day 2: GOULBURN TO ALBURY – Thu 8 Apr 2021 (BD)

Continuing our journey, we arrive into **Holbrook** this afternoon. You might think it's a bit odd but in the middle of this rural NSW town is a life-sized submarine. Our visit to the **Submarine Museum** will reveal why the HMAS Otway's final resting place came to be Holbrook. Through an amazing holograph presentation, we'll hear how a brave young Submariner, whose exploits during the First World War earned him the honour of having the town named after him. We call into the **National Museum of Australian Pottery** – another of the towns interesting attractions. The museum is the only museum in Australia dedicated to 19th and 20th century Australian pottery. We continue onto **Albury**, to unpack and settle in, as this will be our home for the next four nights (breakfast & dinner in hotel / lunch at own expense)

Day 3: ALBURY & CORRYONG – Fri 9 Apr 2021 (BLD)

This morning we take a look around Albury. First, we visit the **Albury Railway Station**, which in 1883, became a “change over station” for passengers between Melbourne and Sydney due to the different railing gauge used in the two states. Prominent hills lie at each end of Dean Street and offer excellent vistas of



Albury and the surrounds. Once aptly named Eastern Hill and Western Hill, a memorial Pillar (to the Soldiers of WWI) resulted in the name change from Western Hill to **Monument Hill**. Next, we visit the **Army Museum Bandiana**, where we explore the comprehensive displays, artefacts of the Boer War to Vietnam and vehicles dating back to the 1920s. With an experienced guide at the **Bonegilla Migrant Experience**, we discover the history of 'Block 19', the last remaining block on the site which received and trained migrants to Australia following World War Two. We travel to **Corryong** where we join in the festivities of the **Man from Snowy River Bush Festival** featuring the **re-enactment of Banjo's famous poem**. See all the action portrayed in the legendary poem, witness the thrills of the unique heritage and hear the iconic poem as it unfolds before our eyes (breakfast & dinner in hotel / packed lunch included)

Day 4: MAN FROM SNOWY RIVER BUSH FESTIVAL - Sat 10 Apr 2021 (BD)

We head to back **Corryong** for a full day at the **Man from Snowy River Bush Festival**. There is a lot happening here today over the festival including a visit to the **Man from Snowy River Museum**, experience fantastic live



entertainment, demonstrations and much more. With plenty of food and beverage stalls to choose from you will easily settle your appetite before the **Street Parade**. Local vehicles,

schools, poets and horse enthusiasts will combine with a variety of historical machinery to modern day utes. They all participate in a well-choreographed parade, making it one of the highlights of the Festival (breakfast & dinner included / lunch at own expense).

Day 5: COUNTRY ART & CRUISING - Sun 11 Apr 2021 (BLD)

We travel to **Benalla** to meet our local guide who will showcase some of the **amazing street art**. Artists from around the world were brought together to paint murals on bare walls, some over three



stories high. Not far, is the **Goorambat Silo**, painted by iconic street artist Dvate, known for his striking renditions of endangered animals. Look up at the rural landscape and endangered Barking Owl featured on the silos. Here we also see the **"Sophia" mural** in the Uniting Church, painted by well-known Melbourne based street artist, Adnate. We head to Yarrowonga where we join the **PS Cumberoona** for a lunch cruise on the tranquil waters of **Lake Mulwala**. We finish our day with a **delightful wine tasting** in Rutherglen (breakfast & dinner in hotel / lunch included).

Day 6: ALBURY TO SOUTHERN HIGHLANDS – Mon 12 Apr 2021 (BL)

We farewell our hosts in Albury and begin our journey home via **Gundagai** where we stop for morning tea
